



## Q2 How long have you been part of the community?



## Q3 How frequently do you visit Downtown Dillon?




## Q4 What is your age?

# Q5 As a young person, what activities would you like to have available to you in Downtown Dillon? Select all that apply.





## Q6 Generally, how do you get to Downtown Dillon?




## Q7 Generally, how long does it take you to get to Downtown Dillon?

## Q8 What is your relationship to Main Street Dillon?



# Q9 As a business owner in Downtown Dillon, what types of support do you receive from Main Street Dillon? Select all that apply.











# Q14 As a property owner, which of the following factors are concerning to you? Please select all that apply.



Q16 What ONE WORD comes to mind when you think about the things you LIKE about Downtown Dillon?




Q17 What ONE WORD comes to mind as you think about things you DISLIKE about Downtown Dillon?

## Q23 Are you familiar with the organization, Main Street Dillon?






## Q25 To what degree do you agree with the following statement: "I feel welcome in Downtown Dillon."






